

FARM RULES - GALUSHA FARM

GENERAL

- The “Golden Rule”... treat this place like your own! If you open a door, close it ... if you open gates ... close them, if you turn on a light ... turn it off before you ride or leave for home.

BARN HOURS

- Open 7 days ... 365 days a year. Pack it up at 9:00 PM.

LOITERING

- This is a place for your horse. It is not a park or picnic area for groups. Enjoy your horse and your family with a picnic at St. James Farm, Herrick Lake, Danada or Blackwell Forest Preserves!
- No one is allowed in the new barn or the hayloft of the old barn.

CHILDREN (under 16 yrs.)

- **Children must be fully attended to AT ALL TIMES.** THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE PASTURE or the CORAL, at any time!

RIDING

- All riders must sign a LIABILITY AGREEMENT; before they ride (sign it once only).
- No sub-leasing of your horse to another person. No riding others' horse(s).
- Stay away from machinery, lawns and crops. If in doubt ... don't go there!
- We have 10,000 acres of riding in our immediate area!
- Follow the school property approved routes, if crossing their property. If you don't know the routes, ASK!

ROAD APPLES

- Shovel them off the driveway after your ride ... sling the apples over the fence into the pasture.
- Pickup the apples right-away, if you cross school property. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL YOU RETURN.

LAWNS & PASTURES

- No riding or lunging in the pastures on Galusha Farm, anytime.
- Keep off the lawn and grass areas, **especially when wet!**
- Keep off the neighbors grass ... along Galusha Rd.
- You may not walk or ride your horse through the back gate **UNLESS THE PASTURE GATE IS OPEN,** indicating that the pasture is dry enough to not make tracks and cut-up the pasture!

FEEDING

- We will feed your horse the hay ... Please do not feed the hay or remove it from the feeders.
- **DO NOT FEED TREATS TO ANYONES HORSE.**

GRAIN

- Sweep up the grain your horse does not eat. Throw it outside in the pasture for the birds to eat. This will keep the mice from coming! Do not feed grain or sweet feed to the cats.
- If you must keep grain at the barn, it must be in a **locked, steel container, approved by Steve.**

SWEEPING

- Sweep-the floor before you leave. Make it nice for the next person who comes in, just the way you would want it when you arrive!
- When you have the farrier out ... sweep up their work too.

GARBAGE

- Take it home with you ... where it came from, or don't bring it!

TACK

- Keep your tack and equipment off the floor ... or Buddy will fetch it and destroy it.
- Keep your tack and equipment on a post, sawhorse, inside your tack box, or take it home. **Nothing on the floor!**

BARN CATS

- The barn cats may be fed ONCE per day. Mark the “cat calendar” by the food bag when the cats are fed. If they have already been fed that day, DO NOT feed them again. ONLY feed cat food to the cats, no grain!

DOGS

- If your dog comes along, clean up after it. They must be able to get along with everyone and Buddy 😊
